

CCPT's Senior Bus 2012 Dial-A-Ride

In coordination with the Office for Aging, CCPT will be utilizing the senior bus in a new way. The use of the senior bus would change from a bus that goes directly to rural senior housing sites into Plattsburgh to a bus that is a dial-a-ride to Plattsburgh service. The service would go to certain areas of the County each day of the week, every other week and be open to the general public. By changing to a dial-a-ride, it would open it up to seniors who are living at home in rural portions of Clinton County, not just at senior housing sites.

The weeks that this bus will operate are as follows for 2012.

Making a reservation

Seniors (anyone 60 years of age and over) would be donation only. They must show proof of age or a senior bus pass. We will be charging a fare to anyone not over 60. This fare is \$10.00 one way. Reservations are required as the bus will not run if there are no reservations. Additionally, seating is limited. When calling to make a reservation, tell the Dispatcher:

1. Your name,
2. Phone number
3. Address
4. If you have a wheelchair, and
5. Your destination in Plattsburgh.
